PROGRAM NOTES

The Fairy Queen, composed in 1692, was one of five semi-operas written by Purcell following the success of his full opera, *Dido and Aeneas* (1689). Purcell's semi-operas or "masques" included spoken text as well as musical interludes and could last as long as four hours if performed in full. These multi-medium performances combined orchestra music, singing, dancing, and spectacle. The elaborate scenic designs were often created by leading architects of the day, and royalty sometimes played the non-singing roles (like Henry VIII and Charles I of England), and some danced in productions (including Queen Anne of Denmark and Louis XIV of France).¹
